Delegations

Gladys Brown expressed her concerns with agriculture and the loss of agricultural land in the area. Ms. Brown also mentioned that she is happy to hear that the Agricultural Land Commission has put a five-year freeze on agricultural land. Council thanked her for coming and for providing them with the informational handouts.

Sarah Winton of the Boundary Country Regional Chamber of Commerce (BCRCC) came to answer Council's questions regarding the video the BCRCC made on the West Boundary. Council was informed that the video was now on the HelloBC website and Ms. Winton feels that it is a valuable tool.

Council explained they are concerned with the lack of representation of Midway and feel that there is more in Midway than the video portrays.

Ms. Winton agreed that the video was rushed but they had to act fast. She

suggested the option of having the video edited to include more of Midway. Ms. Winton informed Council that they were hoping that Area E, Greenwood, Midway and the Chamber would split the cost four ways.

Ms. Winton went on to let Council know that the BCRCC is still not incorporated but hope to hear soon. Council thanked her for coming.
